Reminder

- Education Reform Initiative of South Eastern Europe (ERI SEE) - regional platform for cooperation in the field of education and training
- Member countries (signatories of the MoU, Brdo 2010): Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia , Macedonia , Moldova , Montenegro, and Serbia
- Observers: Bulgaria, Kosovo*, Romania
- Institutional structure:
- ERI SEE Governing Board (representatives of the Ministries of Education from member countries + RCC+KKA) – decision making body, adopt Work Programme and Budget of ERI SEE
- Chair of the ERI SEE Governing Board – Minister of Education, Science and Technological Development of the Republic of Serbia (Host country of the ERI SEE Secretariat)
- ERI SEE Consultative Body (representatives of ETF, CoE, OECD etc.) – advisory role

ERI SEE Secretariat

- In charge for implementation of the ERI SEE Work Programmes
- Second half of 2010 – December 2015 - CEP as ERISSEE Interim Secretariat
- Host Country Agreement – legal base for the establishment of ERI SEE Secretariat as an international organisation – signed by all ERI SEE member countries in June 2015
- January 2016 – establishment of ERI SEE Secretariat
- Call for Director of ERI SEE Secretariat – open until 2 December (vacancy announcement at the www.erisee.org)
- ERI SEE project implementing institution but in the same time to continue the policy dialogue and promote mutual learning and exchange of experiences
- ERI SEE Budget = member countries annual contributions + allocations from the Host Country (Republic of Serbia) + donor contributions (KKA, RCC)
- In the future – additional funding through regional projects after establishment of fully functional ERI SEE secretariat



South East Europe Vocational Education and Training Network - SEEVET-Net

- Established in 2011 under the ERI SEE umbrella through signing of Cooperation Agreement (in Moldova) between VET Centres in SEE
- SEEVET-Net was formed in order to foster a greater relationship between SEE VET institutions and to promote regional co-operation of the National VET institutions acting in the SEECP region
- SEEVET – Net objective is to support implementation of policies in the VET sector contributing to human capital development in a lifelong learning perspective, through policy learning in the context of the objectives related to the EU accession and the “Education and Training 2020”



South East Europe Vocational Education and Training Network - SEEVET-Net

- SEEVET-Net members (signatories of the Cooperation Agreement) - institutions in charge for VET in Albania, B&H, Bulgaria, Macedonia, Moldova, Montenegro, Romania and Serbia
- Participating VET institutions – Croatia and Kosovo*
- Cooperation instruments according to Cooperation Agreement: Peer learning; Exchange of information and experience and good practice sharing; Capacity building for effective roles and responsibilities of VET institutions
- In the future project development: preparation of the project proposal by all SEEVET-Net members; coordination by the Chair of the SEEVET-Net
- ERI SEE Secretariat submits the project proposal and implement the project in cooperation with all SEEVET-Net members

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Some of the key SEEVET-Net achievements

- 7 annual meetings covering different topic identified by countries (e.g. social partnership, WBL)
- 1 study visit to the Netherlands
- 2 training seminars (on validation of prior learning and on graduate traces studies methodologies)
- Participation in all ERISSEE annual conferences
- Participation in work of the Cluster of Knowledge on VET: Modernising VET system – improving performance, quality and attractiveness of VET led by Romania

- Management and coordination of the overall SEEVET-Net work
- Developing the meeting agenda
- Calling the meetings via E-mail
- Representing the SEEVET-Net at other events
- Informing the SEEVET-Net members
- Preparation of the annual work programme of the SEEVET-Net
